Right-To-Know Response

Based on a thorough examination of records in the possession, custody and control of Red Hill Brough, the records you requested do not exist.

If you choose to file an appeal you must do so within 15 business days of the mailing date of the agency's response. See 65 P.S. § 67.1101. Please note that a copy of your original RTKL request, the agency's extension notice (if applicable), and this denial letter should be included when filing an appeal.
