
## Right-to-Know Request

## Good Morning,

Your request for information related to property addressed as 4427 Greens Court was forwarded to me for response. Your requests include the following (responses in red):

- 1. Open/Pending/Expired Permits or fees due The only permits issued for work at this address are associated with the original construction of the townhouse by the original builder/developer. The permit specifically indicates that the structure did NOT include a deck. As can be seen in the 2015 aerial view below, there is now a deck which has been there since at least 2015. The adjacent property (4423) obtained a permit to construct their deck in 2005 but there are no records in our files that suggest the deck at 4427 was ever permitted. (See response below)
- 2. Open Code Violation or fines due as a result of the record search required to respond to this request, the Township has become aware that it appears as though a deck was added to the property without application for or issuance of any permits. The Township has NOT cited the property owner for this apparent violation.
- 3. Unrecorded liens/fines/ special assessments the Township is unaware of any such encumbrances on the property as there is no such information in our files
